they make a \$5.00 contribution to the selected charity of the month. The nonprofit organizations that we support are often recommended by our employees or clients, and selected by a committee of our employees.

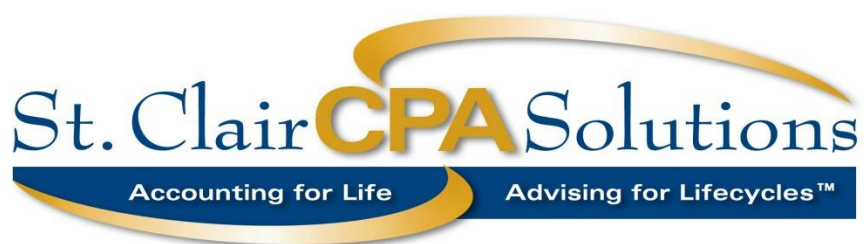

Penn State Children's Hospital was again recognized as one of the top 50 hospitals in the nation for childhood cancer care.
