Collecting food for community food drives has become an annual holiday tradition for our firm in both our New Jersey and Pennsylvania offices. By participating in regional food drives, we proudly support vulnerable families and individuals who are experiencing food insecurity, and work to make their holidays happier by donating food and assisting nonprofit organizations that help those in need.

In the firm's Merchantville, New Jersey office, employees annually collect dry and canned goods from early November through Christmas to support food banks or holiday dinners in our community. Recommendations for social service and faith-based charitable organizations are submitted by our employees and clients, and a committee selects one or more beneficiaries for the holiday season.



In Pennsylvania, on November 6, 2017 we again helped stock the Food Bank run by the Colonial Neighborhood Council (CNC), a nonprofit organization that provides critical social services for the elderly, unemployed, underemployed and disadvantaged in communities surrounding the firm's Conshohocken office. After collecting many pounds of food in our office, a team of our employee volunteers—including **Michele DeSilva, Jamal Charles, Allison Cox, Jamie DiRenzo, Joe LePera, Andrew DeCostanzo and Maureen Cardamone**—helped students from Saint Philip Neri School unload more than 8,000 pounds of food from a school bus and stock the Food Bank's shelves. Students at St. Philip Neri participate in the Fill-a-Bus event each year to support the CNC, and we are proud to help them do this good work.
